

## ***Introduction to Bird Identification***

A short course in identifying the birds within SE Queensland is being offered by Birds Queensland volunteers. Participants will learn to identify birds in general; to recognise the birds to be found in the Brisbane area and gain insights into their characteristics and behaviour. Two evening sessions are held between 7 and 9pm. Two field outings are held on the Saturday and Sunday of the weekend between the evening sessions. Field Guides and course notes provided. Slides, tape recordings and photos are used. There will be discussion of binoculars too.
